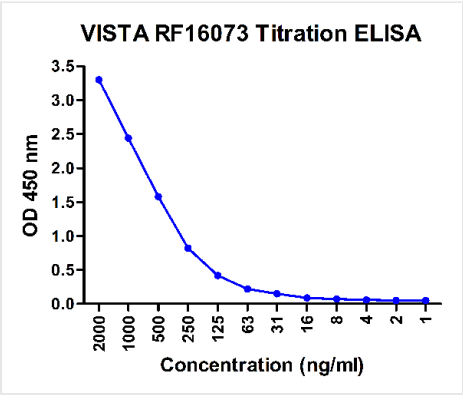

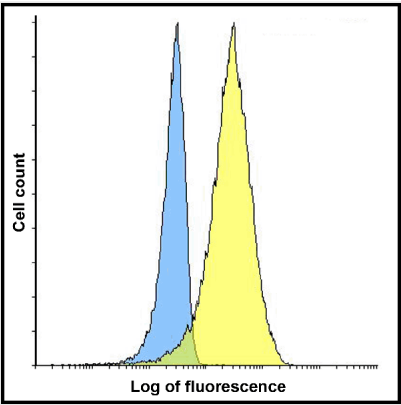

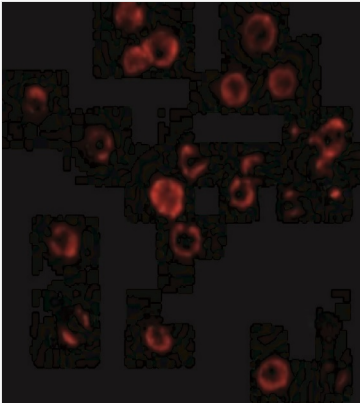

Immunogen	VISTA antibody was raised against the extracellular domain of human VISTA.
Conjugate	Unconjugated
Preparation and Storage	Store at 4 degree C for three months and -20 degree C, stable for up to one year. As with all antibodies care should be taken to avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Antibodies should not be exposed to prolonged high temperatures.



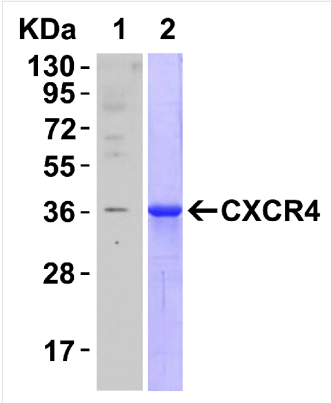

Titration curve analysis of VISTA antibody to detect recombinant VISTA in ELISA at decreasing concentrations.



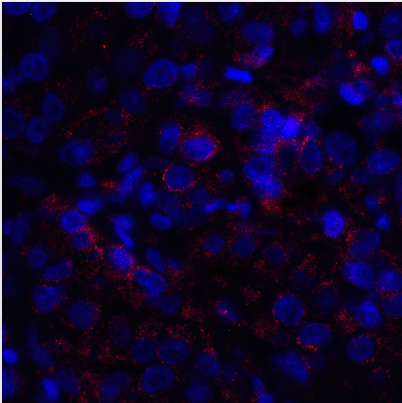
FCM (Flow Cytometry)

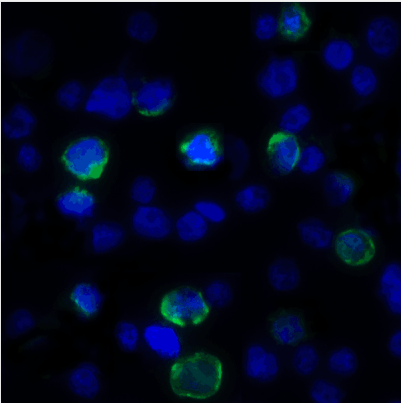
IHC (Immunohistochemistry)

Related Product Information for anti-VISTA antibody

VISTA/B7-H5/platelet receptor Gi24 is a single-pass type I membrane protein located at the cell surface. It is an immunoregulatory receptor which can inhibit T-cell response and may promote differentiation of embryonic stem cells, by inhibiting the BMP4 signaling pathway. The protein can be cleaved by MMP14, and stimulate MMP14-mediated MMP2 activation.
