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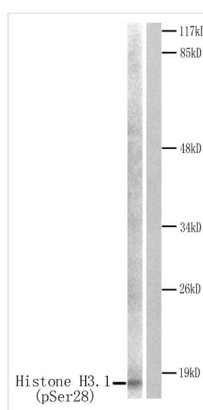

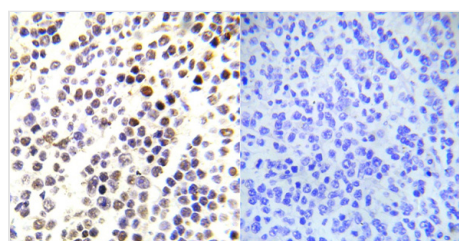
Reactivity	Human, Mouse, Rat
Specificity	Histone H3.1 (phospho-Ser28) antibody detects endogenous levels of Histone H3.1 only when phosphorylated at serine 28.
Purity/Purification	Affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific phosphopeptide. The antibody against non-phosphopeptide was removed by chromatography using non-phosphopeptide corresponding to the phosphorylation site.
Form/Format	In phosphate buffered saline (without Mg ²⁺ and Ca ²⁺), pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.

Applicable Applications for anti-HIST1H3A antibody	ELISA, IHC (Immunohistochemistry), WB (Western Blot)
Immunogen	The antiserum was produced against synthesized phosphopeptide derived from human Histone H3.1 around the phosphorylation site of serine 28(R-K-SP-A-P).
Preparation and Storage	Store at -20 degree C for 1 year
