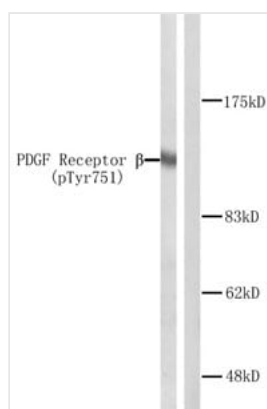

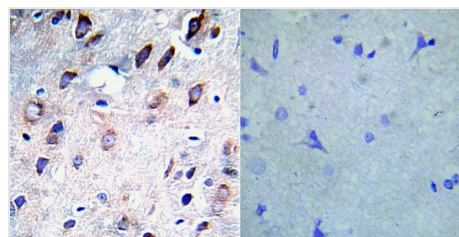

Specificity	PDGFR beta (phospho-Tyr751) antibody detects endogenous levels of PDGFR beta only when phosphorylated at tyrosine 751.
Purity/Purification	Affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific phosphopeptide. The antibody against non-phosphopeptide was removed by chromatography using non-phosphopeptide corresponding to the phosphorylation site.
Form/Format	In phosphate buffered saline (without Mg2+ and Ca2+), pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.
Applicable Applications for anti-PDGFRB antibody	ELISA, IHC (Immunohistochemistry), WB (Western Blot)
Immunogen	The antiserum was produced against synthesized phosphopeptide derived from human PDGFR beta around the phosphorylation site of tyrosine 751 (V-D-YP-V-P).
Preparation and Storage	Store at -20 degree C for 1 year
