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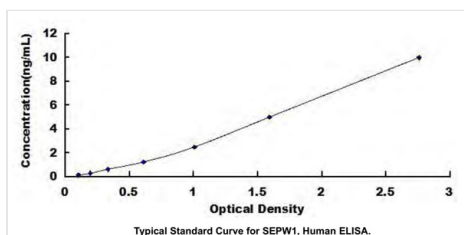

Intra-assay Precision	Intra-assay Precision (Precision within an assay): 3 samples with low, middle and high level SEPW1 were tested 20 times on one plate, respectively. Intra-Assay: CV<10%
Inter-assay Precision	Inter-assay Precision (Precision between assays): 3 samples with low, middle and high level SEPW1 were tested on 3 different plates, 8 replicates in each plate. CV(%) = SD/meanX100. Inter-Assay: CV<12%
Preparation and Storage	Store at 4 degree C for 1 month; -20 degree C for long-term (within shelf life) The stability of kit is determined by the loss rate of activity. The loss rate of this kit is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition. To minimize extra influence on the performance, operation procedures and lab conditions, especially room temperature, air humidity, incubator temperature should be strictly controlled. It is also strongly suggested that the whole assay is performed by the same operator from the beginning to the end.

Related Product Information for SEPW1 elisa kit	Principle of the Assay: The microplate provided in this kit has been pre-coated with an antibody specific to SEPW1. Standards or samples are then added to the appropriate microplate wells with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to SEPW1. Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added, only those wells that contain SEPW1, biotin-conjugated antibody and enzyme-conjugated Avidin will exhibit a change in color. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of 450nm ± 10nm. The concentration of SEPW1 in the samples is then determined by comparing the O.D. of the samples to the standard curve. Intended Uses: The kit is a sandwich enzyme immunoassay for in vitro quantitative measurement of SEPW1 in human tissue homogenates, cell lysates and other biological fluids.
