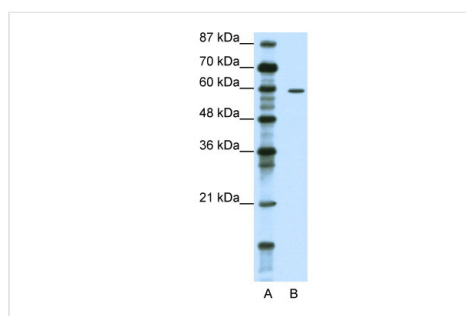

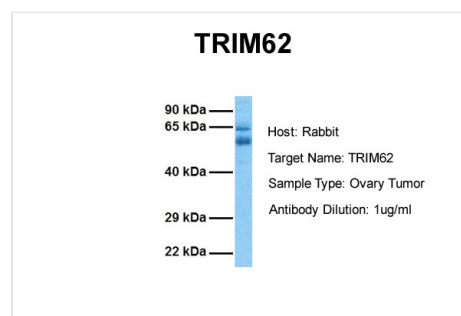

Related Product Information for anti-TRIM62 antibody	This is a rabbit polyclonal antibody against TRIM62. It was validated on Western Blot using a cell lysate as a positive control. Target Description: TRIM62 contains 1 RING-type zinc finger, which is probably involved in mediating protein-protein interactions. RING-type zinc finger was identified in a group of proteins with a wide range of functions such as viral replication, signal transduction, and development. But the function of TRIM62 remains unknown.
