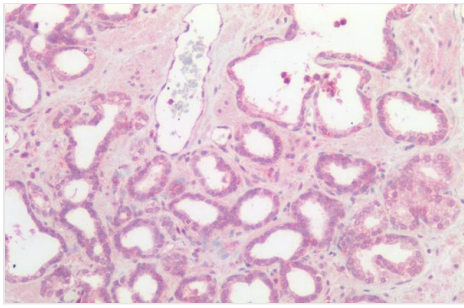

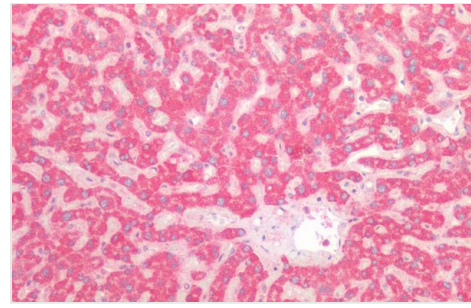
GNAQ Antibody-Human Small Intestine: Formalin-Fixed, Paraffin-Embedded (FFPE)

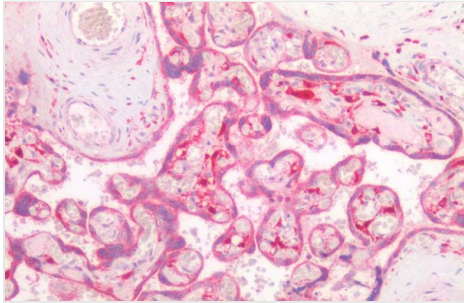
GNAQ Antibody-Human Tonsil: Formalin-Fixed, Paraffin-Embedded (FFPE)



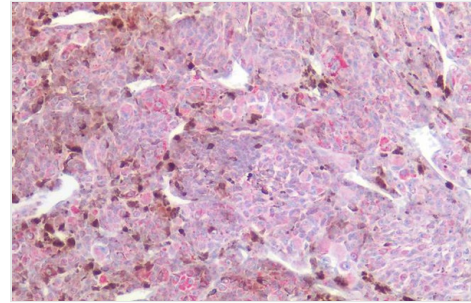

Related Product Information for anti-GNAQ antibody	GNAQ antibody is an unconjugated rabbit polyclonal antibody to GNAQ from human. Validated for IHC. GNAQ (G Protein Subunit Alpha Q) is a part of the trimeric G protein complex group of proteins that bind to G protein coupled receptors and activates signaling pathways. It has been implicated in vascular development and function, and somatic mutations in GNAQ lead to capillary malformations and angiomas in Sturge-Weber syndrome, uveal melanomas, and port-wine stains. It is widely expressed in many tissues, both in the membrane and cytoplasm.
