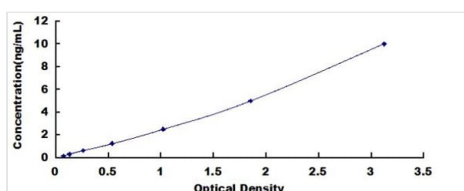

In addition, return the unused wells to the foil pouch containing the desiccant pack and reseal along entire edge of zip-seal.

Related Product Information for TFR2 rtu elisa kit

Test Principle: The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been pre-coated with an antibody specific to TFR2. Standards or samples are then added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells with a biotin-conjugated antibody preparation specific to TFR2. Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added, only those wells that contain TFR2, biotin-conjugated antibody and enzyme-conjugated Avidin will exhibit a change in color. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of 450nm $\pm$ 10nm. The concentration of TFR2 in the samples is then determined by comparing the O.D. of the samples to the standard curve.
