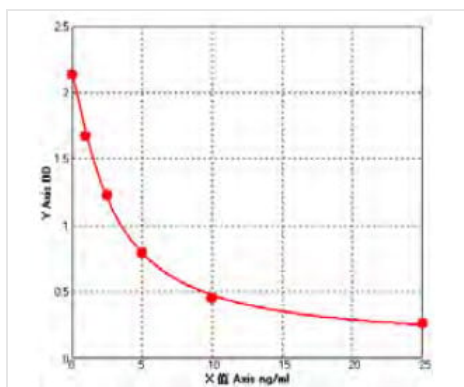

Related Product Information for C1GALT1C1 elisa kit	Intended Uses: This C1GALT1C1 ELISA kit is a 1.5 hour solid-phase ELISA designed for the quantitative determination of Mouse C1GALT1C1. This ELISA kit for research use only, not for therapeutic or test applications! Principle of the Assay: C1GALT1C1 ELISA kit applies the competitive enzyme immunoassay technique utilizing a polyclonal anti-C1GALT1C1 antibody and an C1GALT1C1-HRP conjugate. The assay sample and buffer are incubated together with C1GALT1C1-HRP conjugate in pre-coated plate for one hour. After the incubation period, the wells are decanted and washed five times. The wells are then incubated with a substrate for HRP enzyme. The product of the enzyme-substrate reaction forms a blue colored complex. Finally, a stop solution is added to stop the reaction, which will then turn the solution yellow. The intensity of color is measured spectrophotometrically at 450nm in a microplate reader. The intensity of the color is inversely proportional to the C1GALT1C1 concentration since C1GALT1C1 from samples and C1GALT1C1-HRP conjugate compete for the anti-C1GALT1C1 antibody binding site. Since the number of sites is limited, as more sites are occupied by C1GALT1C1 from the sample, fewer sites are left to bind C1GALT1C1-HRP conjugate. A standard curve is plotted relating the intensity of the color (O.D.) to the concentration of standards. The C1GALT1C1 concentration in each sample is interpolated from this standard curve.
