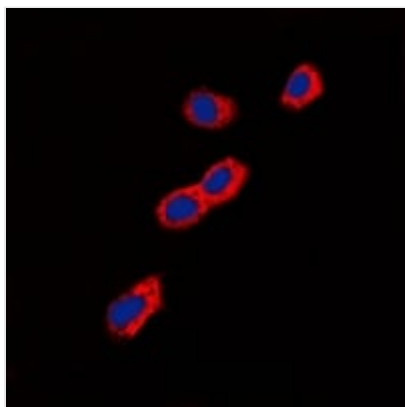

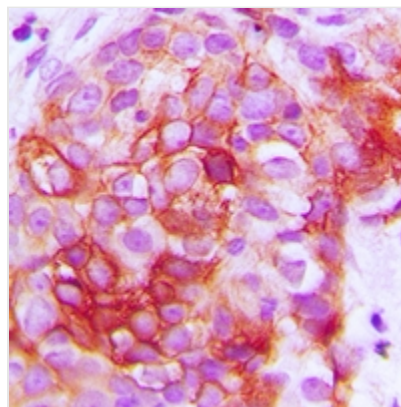

Preparation and Storage	Maintain refrigerated at 2-8 degree C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20 degree C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

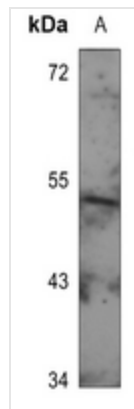

Dilution: WB (1/500 - 1/1000), IH (1/100 - 1/200), IF/IC (1/100 - 1/500)


IHC (Immunohistochemistry)

Dilution: WB: (1/500 - 1/1000), IH (1/100 - 1/200), IF/IC (1/100 - 1/500) Immunohistochemical analysis of GIP Receptor staining in human breast cancer formalin fixed paraffin embedded tissue section. The section was pre-treated using heat mediated antigen retrieval with sodium citrate buffer (pH 6.0). The section was then incubated with the antibody at room temperature and detected using an HRP conjugated compact polymer system. DAB was used as the chromogen. The section was then counterstained with haematoxylin and mounted with DPX.



WB (Western Blot)

Dilution: WB (1/500 - 1/1000), IH (1/100 - 1/200), IF/IC (1/100 - 1/500) Western blot analysis of GIP Receptor expression in HepG2 (A) whole cell lysates.
