Related Product Information for anti-SERPINA3 antibody	BACKGROUND: Alpha 1-antichymotrypsin (?1AC) is an alpha globulin glycoprotein produced in the liver that is a member of the serpin superfamily. In humans, it is encoded by the SERPINA3 gene. ?1AC inhibits the activity of proteases such as cathepsin G from neutrophils and chymases from mast cells by cleaving them into different conformations. This activity protects tissues, such as the lower respiratory tract, from damage caused by proteolytic enzymes. ?1AC is an acute phase protein that is induced during inflammation. Deficiency of this protein has been associated with liver disease, and mutations have been identified in patients with Parkinson disease and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. It is also associated with the pathogenesis of Alzheimer's disease as it enhances the formation of amyloid-fibrils.
