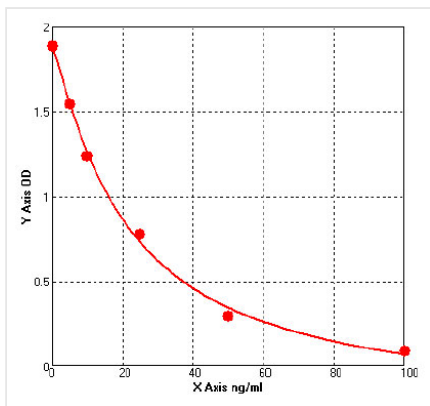

NOTE: Limited by current skills and knowledge, it is impossible for us to complete the cross-reactivity detection between GHRH and all the analogues, therefore, cross reaction may still exist in some cases.

Related Product Information for GHRH elisa kit	Intended Uses: This GHRH ELISA kit is a 1.5 hour solid-phase ELISA designed for the quantitative determination of Canine GHRH. This ELISA kit for research use only, not for therapeutic or test applications! Principle of the Assay: GHRH ELISA kit applies the competitive enzyme immunoassay technique utilizing a polyclonal anti-GHRH antibody and an GHRH-HRP conjugate. The assay sample and buffer are incubated together with GHRH-HRP conjugate in pre-coated plate for one hour. After the incubation period, the wells are decanted and washed five times. The wells are then incubated with a substrate for HRP enzyme. The product of the enzyme-substrate reaction forms a blue colored complex. Finally, a stop solution is added to stop the reaction, which will then turn the solution yellow. The intensity of color is measured spectrophotometrically at 450nm in a microplate reader. The intensity of the color is inversely proportional to the GHRH concentration since GHRH from samples and GHRH-HRP conjugate compete for the anti-GHRH antibody binding site. Since the number of sites is limited, as more sites are occupied by GHRH from the sample, fewer sites are left to bind GHRH-HRP conjugate. A standard curve is plotted relating the intensity of the color (O.D.) to the concentration of standards. The GHRH concentration in each sample is interpolated from this standard curve.
